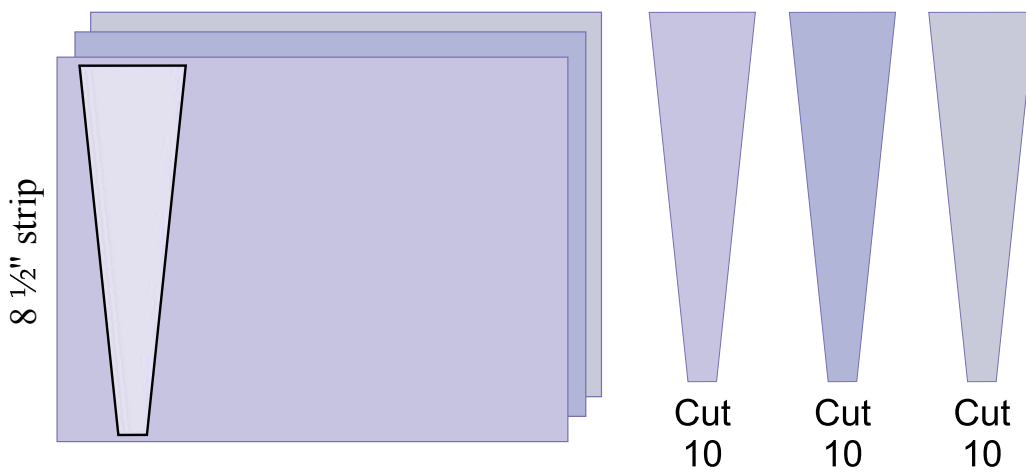
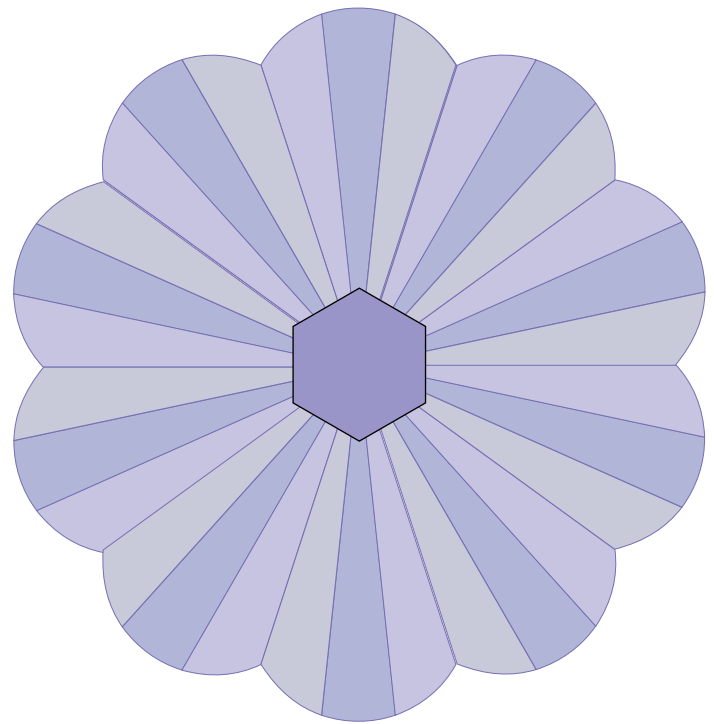
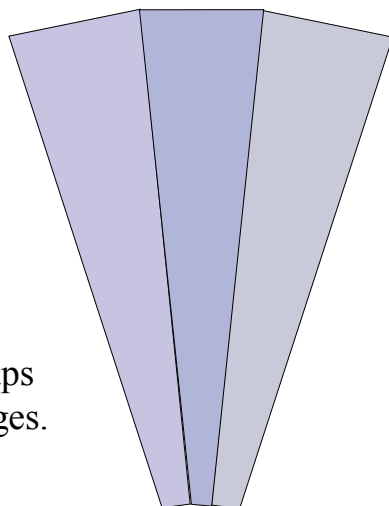


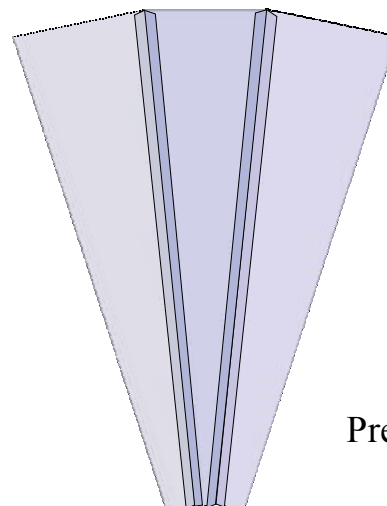
Fabric	Fabric piece	Wedges to Cut	Suggested Yardage
Three Wedge Fabrics	8 1/2" x width strips	10 wedges per color	1/4 yd each
Petal Facing Fabric*	Two 2 1/2" x width strips	10 facing pieces	1/4 yd
<i>*This fabric really doesn't show</i>			
Applique Center	about 6" x 6"	One hexagon applique	1/4 yd each
Backing Square (optional)	At least 20" x 20"		5/8 yd



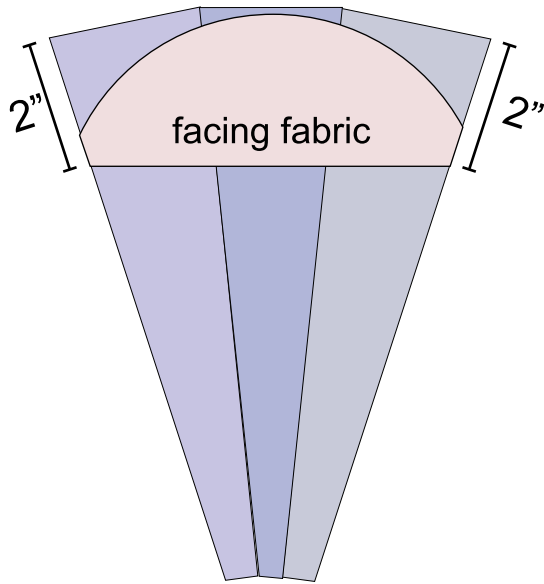
- From each of the 8 1/2" strips, cut 10 wedges.



Sew ten groups of three wedges.

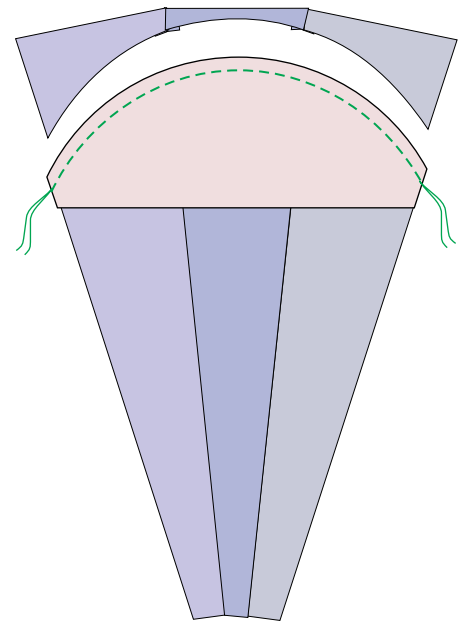


Press seams open.



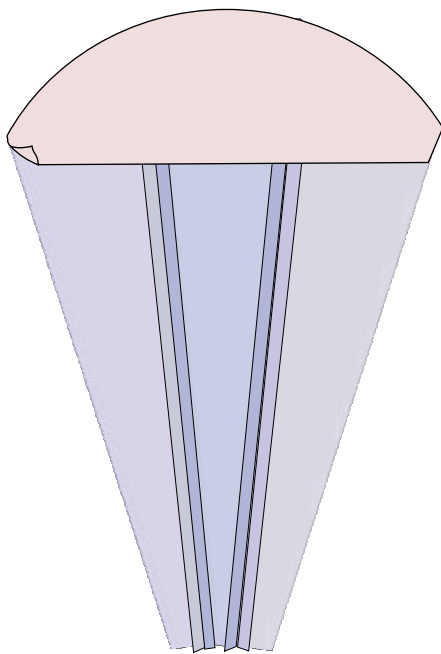
Measure 2" along the side of the wedge sets.

Place the facing piece at the 2" line, right sides together.

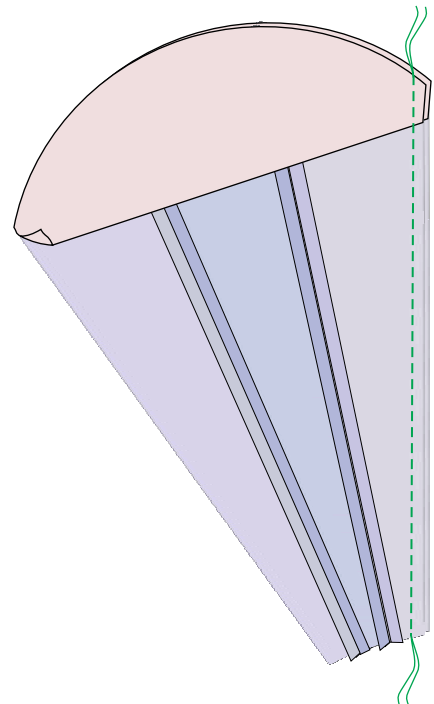


Sew 1/4" from the curved edge of the facing piece.

Trim away the top of the wedge set.



Turn the facing to the other side and press.



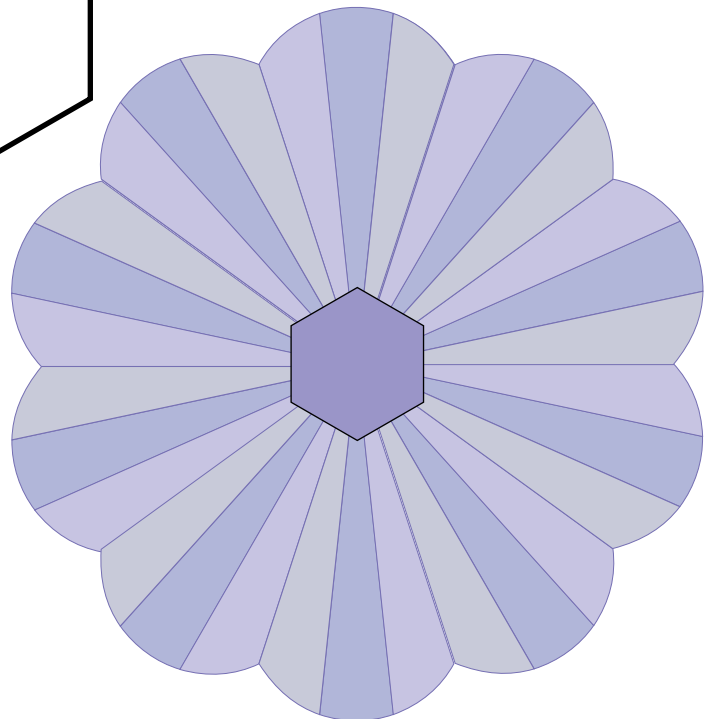
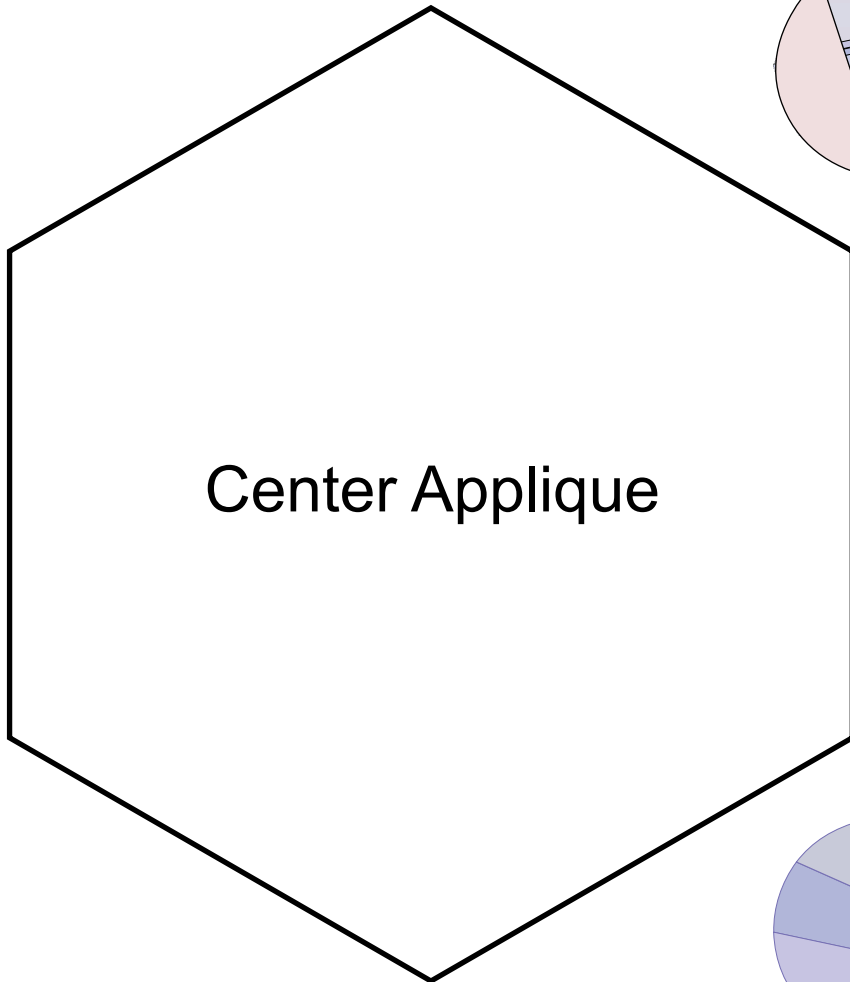
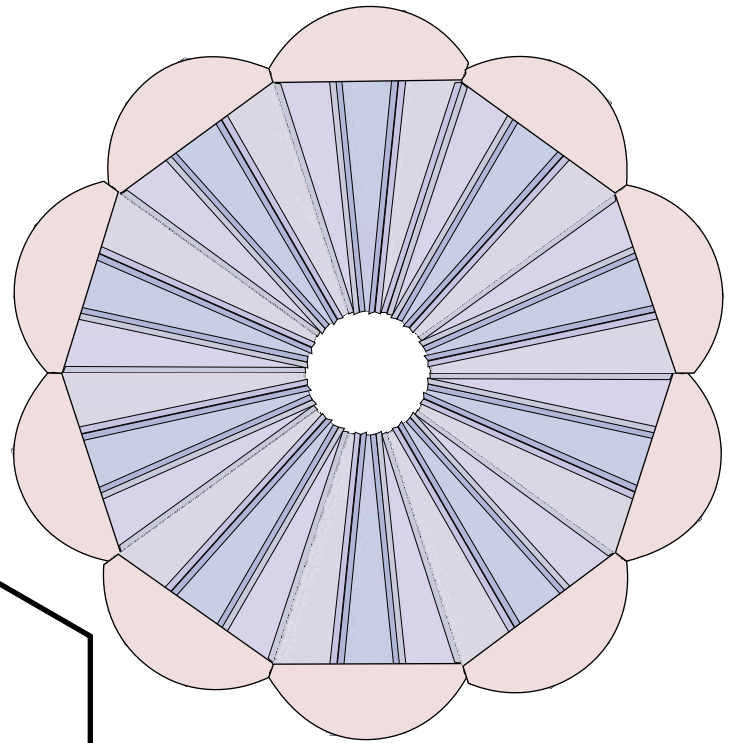
Sew ten petals together to form a flower.

Press seams open.

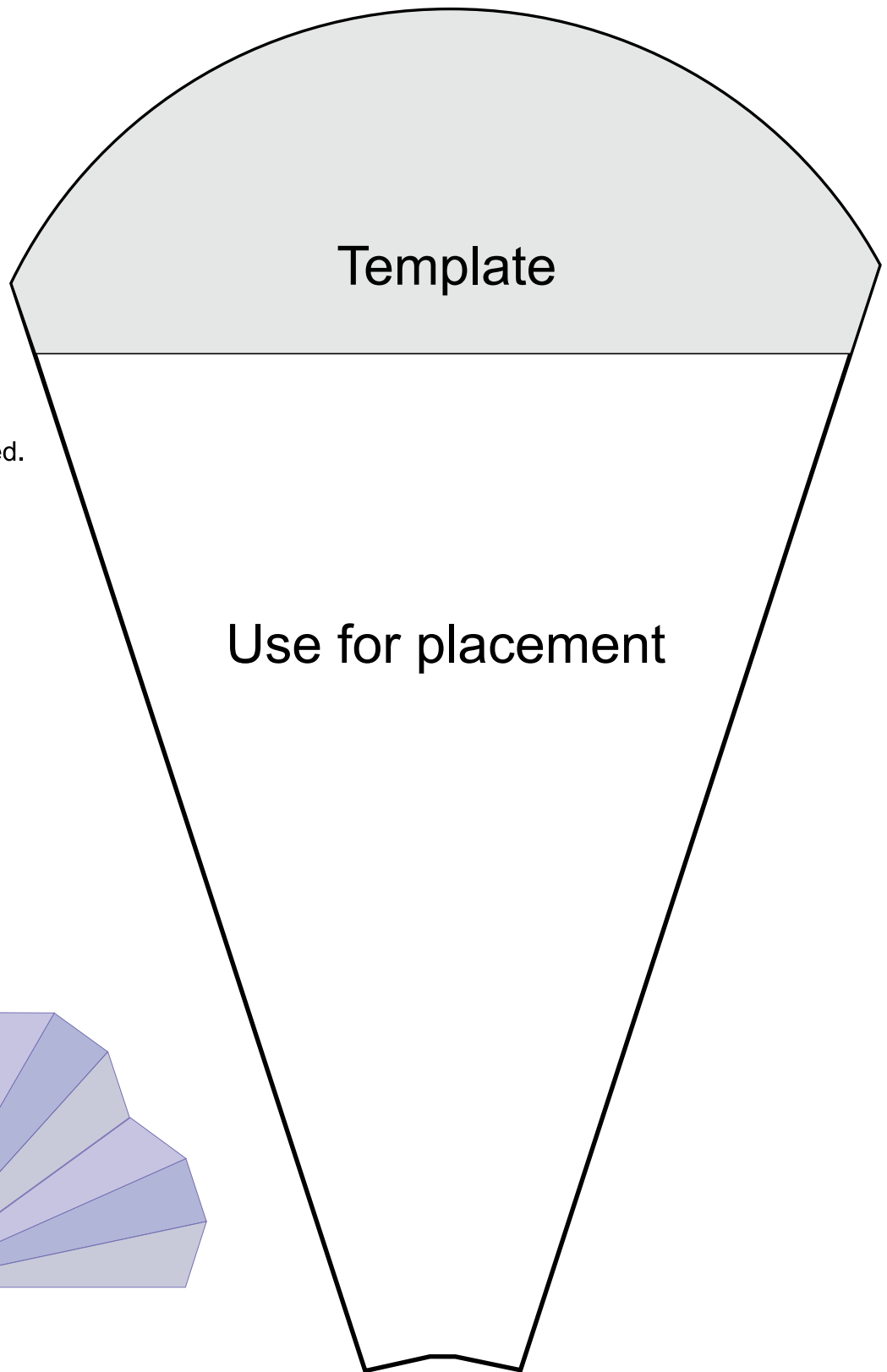
Sew ten petals together to form a flower.

Press the seams open.

Iron a scrap of freezer paper over the center opening to stabilize its circular shape.



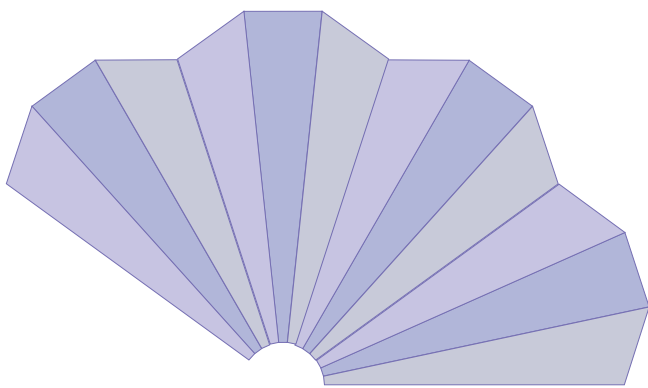
- Make a freezer paper applique tracing the hexagon above.
- Applique the hexagon over the center opening.
- You may applique the flower onto a backing square or you may prefer to fuse a piece of felt to the back.



Cut the shape out, if desired.

Use the shaded area as a pattern piece.

Cut ten of these shapes from your facing fabric.

Sew four petals together for a fan design.
