




The Jewel Box Placemat


Fabric	One or Two Placemats	Four Placemats
A	Fat Quarter	$\frac{1}{4}$ yd
B	Fat Quarter	$\frac{3}{8}$ yd
C	Fat Quarter	$\frac{1}{4}$ yd
D	Fat Quarter	$\frac{1}{4}$ yd
E	Fat Quarter	$\frac{3}{8}$ yd
Backing	Fat Quarter per placemat	1 yd

Fabric	Single Placemat	Two Placemats	Four Placemats
A	One 7" x half width	One 7" x half width	One 7" x width
B	One 5" x half width	One 5" x width	Two 5" x width
C	One 4" x half width	One 4" x width	Two 4" x width
D	One 4" x half width	One 4" x width	Two 4" x width
E	Four 1 1/2" x half width	Four 1 1/2" x width	Eight 1 1/2" x width




Align the fabric edge to the marked line on the tool




Sew D/C to A





Open and press





Cut 4




Sew B to D/C/A






Repeat Steps 1-4 for the right side to make a half





Step 5
Sew the halves together




Step 7
Trim the strips as shown




Sew a border strip to one side
